ABOUT KARUNA SANCTUARY

Some of you will know Karuna as the venue for WinterSong. Located 3 kms out of Katoomba in Blue Mountains, it is set amongst 375 acres of stunning bushland. There are several bushwalks nearby to choose from. Karuna is set up with a roaring fires, cute heated railway carriages and dormitory style accommodation. All meals provided are home-cooked **vegetarian**.

Accommodation

There is a choice of dormitory accommodation or railway carriages (usually two people to a compartment). Both options are heated.

What to bring:

- sheets, pillow, doona or sleeping bag
- blanket to go under your sleeping bag so it doesn't slip
- towel & bathmat
- warm clothing (beanies, gloves, coat)
- warm slippers or ugg boots for inside (we can't wear our shoes inside the hall)
- pencil and notebook
- torch
- harp and other musical instruments
- pillow for chair or own chair (that won't scratch a wooden floor)
- music stand
- recording device
